Positions available (link to position description):

- Regional Delegate - promote advocacy in response to current issues in pharmacy (<http://www.pharmacist.com/node/29367>)
- Regional Member-at-Large - provide student pharmacists in region with membership and patient care activities (<http://www.pharmacist.com/node/29368>).

To qualify as a candidate, you need to:

1. Be a pharmacy student (DPH-1 to DPH-4 accepted)
2. Submit an application (including unofficial transcript and advisor signature)
3. Attend MRM (sessions specific to position candidates)
4. Give a four-minute speech at MRM

How to apply:

An official Application for Elected Regional Office must be submitted to prior to the deadline of 8:00 am on the Saturday of MRM. Applications are available onsite at MRM or online (or below in this email)! Your application must be signed by a WSPS advisor.

Term of office:

Each position serves a one-year term of office. The terms of each APhA-ASP Regional Office start and end at the Midyear Regional Meeting Closing Business Session.

Essay:

Write a concise statement in 200 words or less, which includes your goals for the position you seek, how you would attempt to achieve these goals, and your general philosophies about the APhA Academy of Student Pharmacists, its programs and

activities.
