

PharmD Application Checklist for Fall 2017 Admission

This list is offered as a quick-reference to help you organize your materials. This is not a complete list, so please read the application instructions at <https://pharmacy.wisc.edu/programs/pharmd/admissions/>

Pharmacy College Admission Test (PCAT)

- Send PCAT scores to PharmCAS (code 0104). January 5, 2017, is the latest test accepted for Fall 2017 admissions. Scores from 2013 and earlier will not be accepted.

PharmCAS Application (available July, 2016)

- Complete the PharmCAS application by **January 5, 2017**. The application and instructions are available at www.pharmcas.org. We encourage applicants to apply early to benefit from more available seats early in our admissions process, but will accept all applications submitted on or before January 5, 2017. Decide if you want to use the Early Decision admission process (**Deadline: September 6, 2016**).
- Send official transcripts from each college attended and at least three letters of recommendation to PharmCAS.
- Frequently check your application status through PharmCAS to track the status of transcripts, recommendations, PCAT scores, and your supplemental application to make sure they were received. Contact PharmCAS regarding any materials not received.

University of Wisconsin-Madison Supplemental Application (available July, 2016)

- Submit the supplemental application by **January 5, 2017**. The supplemental application is available at <https://apps.pharmacy.wisc.edu/pharmdapply/>. You must begin your PharmCAS application prior to submitting your supplemental application. You will need your PharmCAS ID number to access the application. Again, we encourage applicants to apply early in the process.
- Pay by credit card when submitting application OR

- Mail a photocopy of your Green Card (front and back) to the School of Pharmacy.

International Students

- Submit TOEFL scores to PharmCAS (see the application instructions for details).
- Submit the Fall 2017 Financial Verification Form, funding documentation, a sponsor funding statement, I-20 and VISA documentation (see the application instructions for details).
